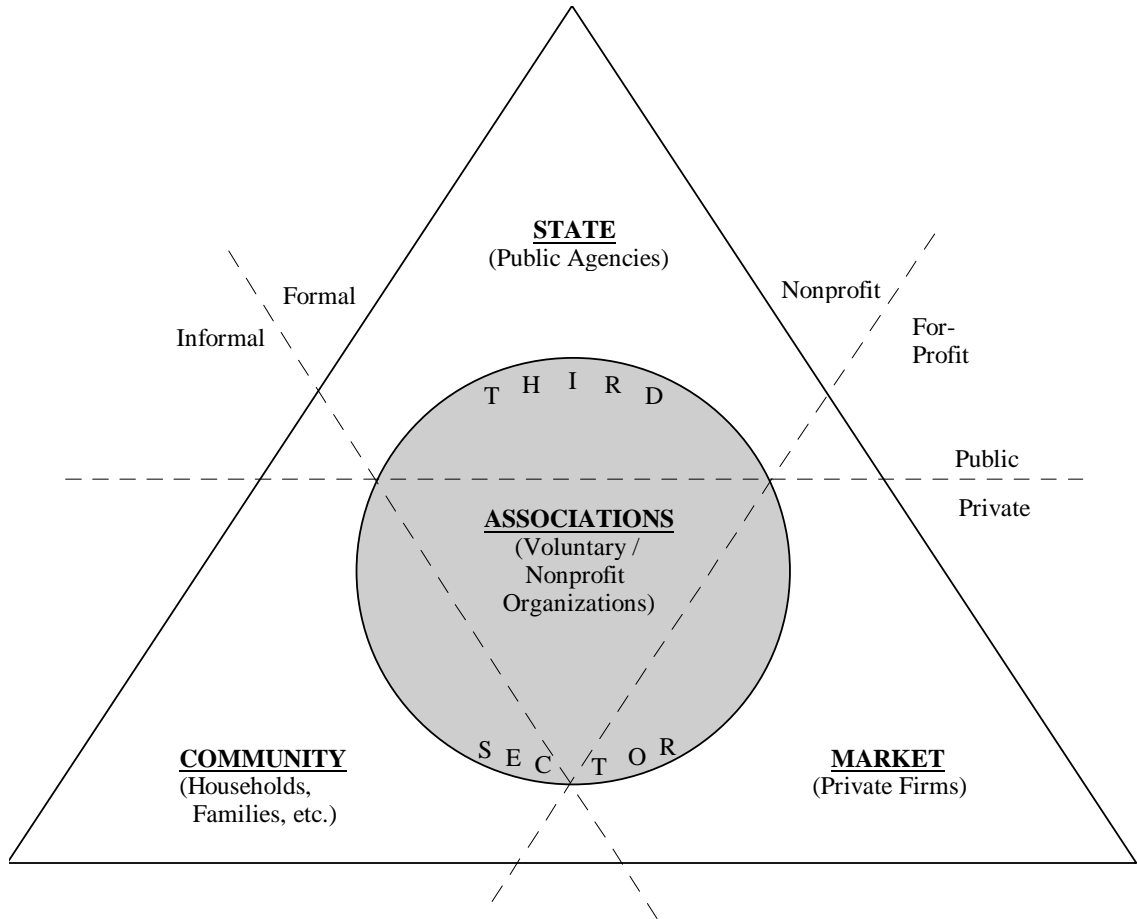


**Figure 1**      **The Third Sector in the Welfare Triangle**

**Figure 2. Exit, Voice and the Type of Goods or Services**

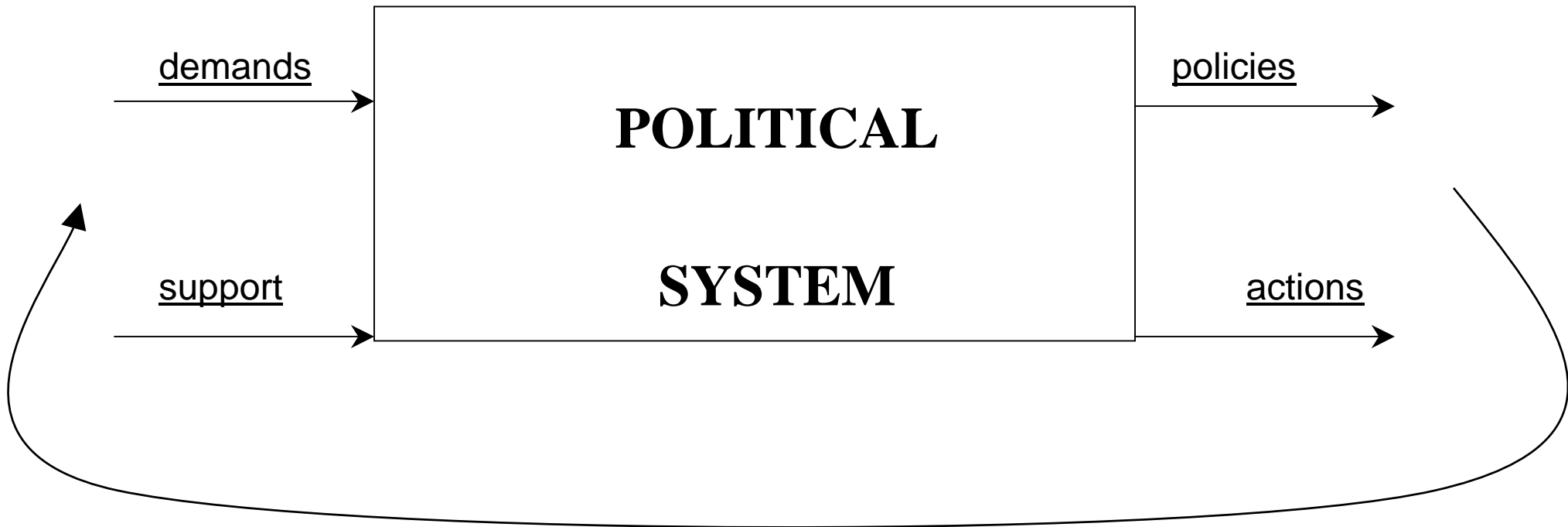

Figure 3 Easton's Model of a Political System.

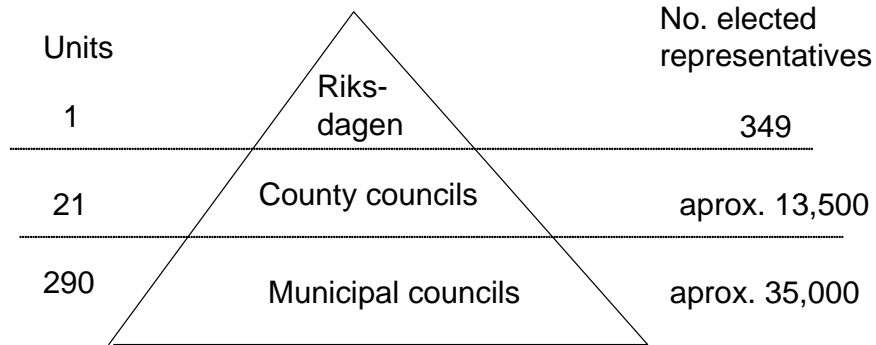
